- If you are **only** attending ADULT Camp, select the Adult Clinic form.
- If you are attending **at least one YOUTH Camp**, select the Youth Clinic form and register for **all** camps you will attend. You only need to complete ONE form.
 - 1) Youth Camp 1 only (May 31) - as Youth or Adult
 - 2) Youth Camp 2 only (Jun 7)- as Youth or Adult
 - 5) Youth Camp 1 (May 31) and ADULT Camp (Jun 28)
 - 6) Youth Camp 2 (Jun 7) and ADULT Camp (Jun 28)
 - 7) Youth Camp 1 (May 31) and Youth Camp 2 (Jun 7)
 - 8) All three camps

Only online registrations submitted by the deadline with credit card payment via Event Manager will be accepted. Participants who register by the early deadline save \$45 off full fee [\$225]. See the Registering as a Counselor/Adult Volunteer section for details on the cost of camp for adult volunteers at Youth Camp.

- All applications MUST be submitted by the final deadline. Incomplete or late applications will not be honored.
- Be sure to include your correct membership (Gup or Dan) number and studio name on the application.

Adult Volunteer Information

Thank you for your interest in assisting students at the Youth Dan Clinics! Your help as counselor, session instructor/assistant, runner, medical staff, or other duty is greatly appreciated!

Camp organizers are always looking for assistance in providing the best possible experience for our youth students. In the event there is an excess of volunteers for cabin counselors, volunteers will be notified in advance of the possibility of other duties that may be available.

Review all materials below and submit the following:

- Via your instructor, proof of proper clearances
- At Youth Camp check-in, submit your signed Camp Counselor Statement

All volunteers are **REQUIRED** to register online and submit proof of all necessary clearances to volunteer in any capacity at the Youth Dan camps prior to camp. In Pennsylvania, adults who are charged with care of children (e.g., our overnight Youth Dan Camps), or regular contact such with children (e.g., during classes on a weekly basis) are required by law to have a background check conducted every five (5) years. There are also requirements around the mandatory reporting of suspected child abuse.

- Submit proof of proper clearances to your instructor for submission to Master Ken Peterman as soon as possible (by May 2).

Registering as a Counselor/Adult Volunteer

Please note: All volunteers must register online through EM and read, sign, and submit your Camp Counselor Statement at check-in. The fee schedule for **adult volunteers** follows:

- A volunteer attending only one Youth camp will pay the full registration fee for that camp.
- A volunteer attending two Youth Camps will pay for their first Youth camp (there is no fee for the second Youth camp). You will receive your T-shirt at your first Youth Camp.
- A volunteer attending one or both Youth Camps and Adult Camp will pay the full Adult camp fee (there is no fee for the Youth camp(s)). You will receive your T-shirt at your first Youth Camp.
- Those registering for the Adult Camp will pay the full Adult Camp fee regardless of their attendance as a volunteer at a Youth Camp.
- The discount only applies to the main registration fee; it does not apply to judging certification or other clinic fees.
